

HERITAGE TREE(S) NOMINATION FORM

Do you have a special tree or group of trees that you believe warrant special protection in your community? - Grove – small usually irregular pocket of trees, up to 0.5 hectares;
- Arboreal Remnant – larger pocket of trees, 0.5 to 5 hectares, but not a woodlot.
