 - Public Works (by old train station)
 - Ritchie Street

Recycling

Bag #1

clean, dry, crushed and /or uncapped

- beverage containers
- aluminum cans
- plastic & glass bottles
- metal cans & lids
- glass jars & metal lids
- recyclable plastic containers
- plastic bags (grocery, bread etc)
- aluminum foil, plates & trays

**Redeemable beverage containers may be taken to
the Lequille Enviro-Depot for a cash rebate**

Bag #2

clean and dry

- Newspaper & newsprint
- Glossy /non glossy flyers
- Magazines, catalogues & phonebooks
- Writing /typing /computer paper
- Envelopes (windows removed)
- Paper egg cartons
- Tissues, tissue and cereal boxes
- Paper towel / bathroom tissue tubes
- Gable top milk & juice cartons
- Corrugated cardboard

reduce, reuse & recycle

Curbside Collection Rules:

Garbage: maximum of 3 bags

- Regular size, black, brown or green bags
- Must not weigh more than 15lbs when full
- Grocery bags; maximum of 3 still applies

Recyclables: maximum of 4 bags

- Refers to any combination of Clear Bag 1 & 2 to a total of 4 bags
- Clear colourless bags
- Must not weigh more than 15kg when full
- If corrugated cardboard does not fit into a bag it must be flattened and bundled to a size not exceeding 2 feet, by 2 feet, by 2 feet (2 bundles max)

Businesses

- Businesses are permitted to have a maximum of 6 garbage bags and 8 recyclable bags.

What About These...

Batteries ~ can be dropped off at the Management Centre in Lawerancetown. If they are rechargeable, many retailers will accept them.

Styrofoam ~ must be disposed of with your regular garbage waste.

Cooking Oil/Fat ~ let the oil/fat cool and then place in a cardboard box like a cereal box and place in your composter.

Computers ~ computers and computer parts are considered garbage and therefore must be disposed of during the spring/fall cleanup.

Propane Tanks ~ less than 20lbs can be dropped off at Home Hardware or Lequille Country Store.

Car Tires ~ any tire dealership will accept used tires or you can dropped them off at Lequille Country Store

Small household appliances ~ spring and fall clean-up days

Hazardous Waste ~ any products that contain the these labels     can be dropped off at the Lawrencetown Transfer Station
